Scholarship Name	Eligibility Criteria
<b>Boeing Business Scholarship</b>	Demonstrated financial need
<b>Ben B. Cheney Foundation</b>	Minimum GPA of 3.0 or above Strong involvement in extracurricular activities Academic merit should be considered first and financial need second in determining business students to receive awards. The scholarship is to recognize achievement, and should be made as an award for that achievement in the amount of \$2,000 to each student. Four Cheney awards should be made each year.
<b>Alma and Gil Centioli</b>	Full-time Junior or senior Business students
<b>Dean's Business Forum</b>	For Undergraduate and Graduate students majoring in Business Minimum GPA of 2.5 (undergraduate), 3.0 (graduate) Minimum 15 hours per week employment (exclusive of work study) Letter of recommendation from current employer Demonstrated financial need
<b>Henri P. Charvet, S.J.</b>	For undergraduate students enrolled in the School of Business Administration who maintain a GPA of 3.0 and who are from middle income families with financial need. Preference given to accounting majors.
<b>Jack and Kathleen Neupert</b>	Demonstrated financial need For deserving students pursuing degrees offered through the School of Business Administration.

<b>Puget Sound Business Forum</b>	Junior or senior Graduate of a Puget Sound area high school Demonstrated financial need For business majors with financial need who have graduated from a greater Puget Sound area high school. The recipient must be a junior or senior with good academic standing.
<b>Mt. Roothaan</b>	Sophomore, junior or senior Minimum GPA of 3.2 Students should be well-rounded and strong involvement in extracurricular activities Demonstrated financial need For business majors with a minimum of 3.2 GPA..
<b>Teresita Coombes Scholarship</b>	For deserving full-time undergraduate business students with demonstrated financial need, in good academic standing with a 2.75 or higher cumulative GPA. Awards are to be renewed as long as the student meets specified criteria. Recipients may be chosen at the discretion of the Dean of the School of Business.
<b>Louie and Donna Lapke Scholarship</b>	Undergraduate School of Business major Demonstrated financial need For high-need undergraduate business majors.
<b>Evergreen Business Capital</b>	For students within the School of Business One male and one female will be awarded a scholarship Preference to students participating in the Hogan Entrepreneurial Leadership Program.
<b>Various Accounting Scholarships</b>	There are several accounting scholarships awarded annually from accounting firms. Please go to <a href="http://www.jepson.gonzaga.edu/accounting">www.jepson.gonzaga.edu/accounting</a> for additional information.
