**John Dienhart** is the Frank Shrontz Chair for Professional Ethics at Seattle University. He is the director of the Northwest Ethics Network, an independent group of ethics and compliance officers from the business, nonprofit, and governmental sectors and an Invited Fellow of the Ethics Resource Center in Washington D.C. He consults with and does ethics training for companies including Bonneville Power Administration, Costco, Microsoft, Russell Investment Group, Starbucks, T-Mobile, Washington Mutual, and Weyerhaeuser. Dr. Dienhart comments on business ethics have appeared in newspapers across the country, including the New York Times, The Washington Post, the LA Times, the Puget Sound Business Journal, the Seattle Times, the Seattle PI, and the San Francisco Chronicle. He is the author of several books, including *Business, Ethics, and Institutions* (Oxford University Press 2000), and several articles including "The Ethical Commitment to Compliance: Building Value-Based Cultures" in the *California Management Review* (Winter 2008). His current research focuses on the intersection of ethical decision making, leadership, CSR, and sustainability.



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
