Born in Rotterdam he was a European ahead of his time, using books, the latest form of communication at that time.

PROGRAM COST

Gonzaga University tuition + Erasmus room & board charges. Airfare and textbooks are not included.

PASSPORT AND VISAS

All students must have a valid passport to study in the Netherlands and it should be valid six months beyond their stay in Europe. In addition, US students staying in the Netherlands for a period longer than 3 months have to obtain a Residency Permit (VTV: Vergunning tot Verblijf). APPLICATION DEADLINE

Fall 2012 / Spring 2013: **February 1, 2012**

Early application is encouraged. Incomplete applications will not be considered until all documents have been received.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Erasmus Exchange program is open to all undergraduates who have completed sophomore year by the time they study abroad. All courses are taught in English. Admission to the program is based on the following criteria:

- ◆ 3.0 GPA
- ◆ Two letters of academic recommendation
- ◆ Clearance forms

5. \$50 non-refundable application fee payable online
