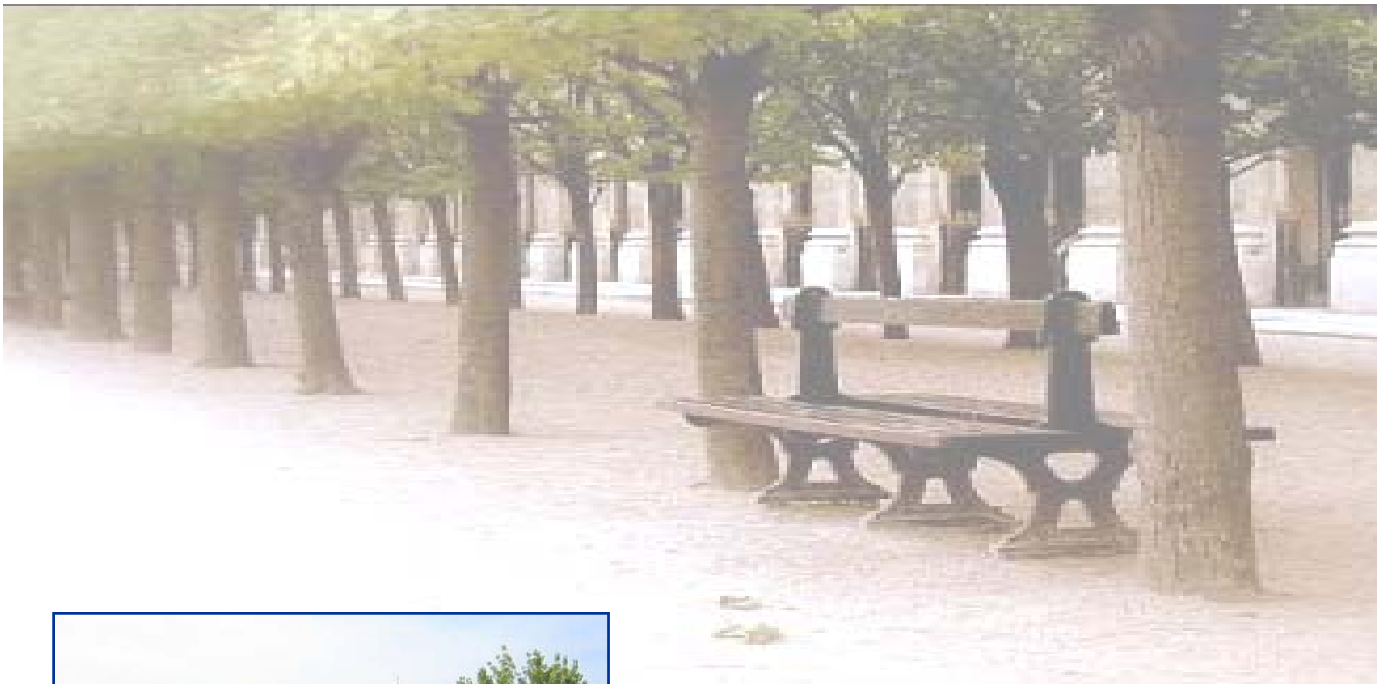

★The REAL European Experience★

Gonzaga-in-Paris is a year or semester-long program for French majors and minors (some flexibility is required for the semester program). The purpose of the Paris Program is **complete immersion** in the French culture and language with the specific goal of **achieving fluency**. The student walks away with immeasurable personal growth, self-confidence, and the satisfaction that comes with having mastered a language and a culture. The Paris Program is challenging but students receive continuous personalized support from the director in Paris and the director in Spokane.



AUTHENTIC IMMERSION

- ★Classes in French at L'Institut Catholique de Paris or La Sorbonne
- ★Francophone roommates
- ★Conversational and social venues



EXCEPTIONAL ACCOMODATIONS

- ★Dorms (also known as “foyers” or “pensions”) located in the 4th and 14th arrondissements.
- ★Friendly, welcoming housing staff; Easy access to school, notable Parisian “quartiers” and tourist destinations.

FIRST-CLASS EDUCATION

- ★Students attend the Institut de Langue et Culture Francaises (the ILCF) at the Institut Catholique during fall semester. ILCF professors are specially trained in and have extensive experience teaching French as a second language.
- ★Classrooms are diverse with students from all over Europe, Asia and the United States.
- ★Challenging academic program. Students can earn credits for a **French major or minor, and for other disciplines** as well, if they are ambitious.



ENDLESS OPPORTUNITIES

- ★Several long vacations = **time for traveling around Europe!**
- ★Program events organized by the Paris Director and covered in the Program cost: Soirée Bateaux Mouches (boat ride on the Seine), Soirée Moulin Rouge, trips to Normandy (Mont St. Michel) and the Loire Valley (fall grape harvest)
- ★Work opportunities – babysitting and tutoring – the Gonzaga program has established relationships with Parisian families and it is easy to find job listings at the American Church.
