\$10,000 over four years

**Awarded to Outstanding High School Graduates Enrolling in the School of Business at
Gonzaga University**

Background:

Professor Daniel Brajcich taught in the Accounting Department of the School of Business Administration at Gonzaga University for over 50 years. He established a flagship program that has developed graduates who now head corporations, CPA firms, and universities. In 1987, grateful alumni founded the Daniel Brajcich Scholarship Fund to assist students interested in pursuing a business degree at Gonzaga University.

Scholarships:

The Brajcich Scholarship offers financial assistance of **\$2,500 per year, renewable for four years**, to outstanding students who demonstrate financial need and enroll in the School of Business Administration during their freshman year at Gonzaga. Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain good academic standing, a minimum 2.75 GPA, and full-time status with a major in the School of Business Administration.

Application Requirements:

- Complete the Application for Admission to Gonzaga University by February 1.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by February 1.
- Complete the **personal information** section below and submit with the **required application essay**.
- Submit an essay of **700 words or less** that describes your career goals and interests.
- Intend to enroll with a major in the School of Business Administration at Gonzaga University.
