Meal Plans:

Food services to the University students are provided by Sodexo Dining Services. The University facilitates these arrangements by billing, collecting and remitting the charges for services. Six meal plans are offered:

Platinum: \$2,087.00

This plan allows unlimited access to the resident dining facility, including Late Night Dining, plus \$275.00 Dining \$ for purchases at any campus dining retail location.

Gold: \$1,952.00

This plan allows unlimited access to the resident dining facility, with the exception of Late Night Dining, plus \$295.00 Dining \$ for purchases at any campus dining retail location.

Silver: \$1,815.00

This plan allows access to the resident dining facility during the lunch and dinner hours Monday-Friday, and brunch and dinner hours Saturday- Sunday, plus \$345.00 Dining \$ for purchases at any campus dining retail location.

Bronze: \$1,679.00

This plan allows 100 block meals at the resident dining facility during normal and Late Night Dining hours, plus \$495.00 Dining \$ for purchases at any campus dining retail location.

Copper Dinner: \$1,574.00

This plan allows access to the resident dining facility during dinner hours only Monday-Sunday, plus \$475.00 Dining \$ for purchases at any campus dining retail location.

Copper Lunch: \$1,574.00

This plan allows access to the resident dining facility during lunch hours only Monday-Sunday, plus \$475.00 Dining \$ for purchases at any campus dining retail location.

Payment Options

Outlined below are the University's payment options. All payment arrangements are coordinated with any applicable financial aid which you may receive. **Students who have financial aid which meets or exceeds their charges are not eligible for the monthly installment plans.**

Student Accounts accepts cash and checks for payment on account. Electronic payment is also available which includes e-Check at no charge to the student and credit card payment through American Express, Diner's Club, MasterCard and Discover, with a 2.75% service fee. The estimated total cost for fall and spring semesters, less verified financial aid, can be set up in ten equal monthly installments.

Payments are due monthly, the first of each month, beginning July 1, 2009.

8-Month Note (Academic Year)

The estimated total cost for fall and spring semesters, less verified financial aid, may be set up in eight equal monthly installments.

Application and \$100 fee must be received in the Student Accounts Office by August 3, 2009.

Payments are due monthly, the first of each month, beginning September 1, 2009.

Students accepted after installment plan deadline dates may still apply within 2 weeks of their acceptance, making up any missed payments.

The estimated total cost for fall semester, less verified financial aid, can be set up in four or five equal monthly installments.

Third Party Sponsors

If your student account balance is to be paid by a corporate or foreign sponsor, a government agency, or a religious institution, a scholarship foundation or trust account, we require written proof of sponsorship from that agency in the Student Accounts Office to confirm your classes.

Adjustments for Dropped Courses

After classes commence, tuition adjustments for dropped courses will be computed as follows: During the first week of classes you would receive 100% refund, you would receive 80% refund the second week of classes, there will be no tuition refund made after the second week of school.

Complete Withdrawal from the University

Students completely withdrawing will obtain a Complete Withdrawal form from the Law Registrar's Office. Tuition adjustments are calculated in Student Accounts. Final adjustments are based on the effective dates of complete withdrawals.* Room and Board will be prorated throughout the semester. Financial aid refunds will be returned in accordance with governmental and University regulations.

**The tuition adjustment schedule for complete withdrawals is posted in the Student Accounts Office.*

The University reserves the right to change any costs and/or provisions without notice. It further reserves the right to withhold student information, including transcripts of record and diplomas, until said student's account has been paid in full. No student will be allowed to register for an ensuing semester if a balance is owed for a prior semester.

A finance charge of 12% per annum pro rata (365 days) or a rebilling fee of 1% of the total amount due or \$3, whichever is greater, will be added to a student's account on any amount more than thirty days past due.
