1. Ken Sammons passed out a brochure produced by one of the interns, "Gonzaga University: A quick guide to going green, college style!" We discussed suggestions for revision and ways that this could be passed out to the students.
2. We spent the remainder of the time discussing the University Presidents' Climate Commitment, specifically which 2 of the 7 actions plans we should support. We came to a consensus on items b. (adopt policy to buy Energy Star products) and g. (participate in national RecycleMania competition) which were suggested by Brian in an earlier e-mail. However, item a. (Establish a policy that all new campus construction will be built to at least the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED Silver standard or equivalent) was very attractive to several members, and we discussed the feasibility of either supporting this action item or proposing it at a later time.
