Credits

MBA/JD

The JD is a 90-credit degree and the MBA is a 33-credit degree. Dual program students can waive a combination of 9 credits from both programs combined (for a total of 114 credits), but cannot waive more than 6 credits from either program.

MAcc/JD

The MAcc program is a 30-credit degree. Dual Program students can waive a combination of 9 credits from both programs combined (for a total of 111 credits), but cannot waive more than 6 credits from either program.

These dual degree programs require students to apply to both schools separately. You are required to take the GMAT exam for the MBA & MAcc programs and the LSAT exam for the JD program.

Gonzaga University's Graduate School of Business and Law School programs educate the whole person. These programs prepare students for careers in the rapidly changing and increasingly demanding business and legal environments.

The **PLACEMENT** rate for MBA & MAcc graduates is approximately 90% within 6 months of graduation. Many students secure jobs well before they graduate. Students are encouraged to participate in our internship program.

Business **CLASSES** are offered in the early morning, evening and during the day to accommodate those students who are employed full-time or part-time.

Numerous business **SCHOLARSHIPS** are available to resident and international students. Both Gonzaga endowments and generous contributions from outside organizations make this possible.

Gonzaga's Business School offers several **GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS** that pay for a portion of tuition for full-time students

Students can apply for **ADMISSION** and begin classes in the fall, spring, summer I or summer II semesters. However, Dual Degree students are not allowed to take business classes during the first two semesters of law school.

Important Notes

Bar Exam

In order to sit for the bar exam, students must either complete all requirements for the MBA/JD or MAcc/JD, or complete 90 JD credits by June (summer session 1) for the July bar exam or December (fall semester) for the February bar exam.

Tuition

MBA and MAcc tuition is \$710/credit (2008-2009) which varies from Law School Tuition of \$1,004/credit (2008-2009). You will be charged the tuition amount based on the specific courses you are taking.
