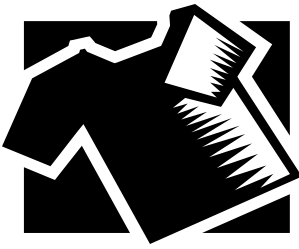

DID YOU KNOW?

Grading at the Graduate Level (600 or above) -

At the graduate level the lowest grade a student can earn and still receive credit for a course is a C. Anything less than a C is treated as an F and no credit is awarded. In order to graduate all graduate students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 in their 600 level courses. See 07-09 Graduate Catalog pages 12/13 for more information.

Dropping or Withdrawing from a Graduate Course -

Students have 1 week from the first day of class to DROP a course (removes course from transcript, no grade assigned, and tuition is reimbursed). After that they can WITHDRAW (course shows on transcript with a W grade, but does not impact their GPA, and no tuition reimbursement). Students can WITHDRAW from a course up until 3 weeks of the last day of the course. Proper paperwork must be processed for both dropping and withdrawing from courses. Mandatory Immunization Policy

As a reminder, every student is **required** to show proof of at least two Mumps, Measles, and Rubella (MMR) vaccinations or two Rubeola vaccinations. In lieu of that they may show proof of a positive titer (a blood test that shows an immunity) for measles.
