Mission Statement

Center Pointe is a non-profit United Way member agency offering classes and activities based on the principles of recreational therapy. Classes are offered to individuals with developmental disabilities living in the Spokane area.

Center Pointe provides recreational socialization and educational opportunities for people with disabilities. Classes are held during the day, Monday through Friday with evening activities when possible. The Center program was developed to give them a "place of their own".

Participants are enrolled in specific classes such as arts and crafts, sewing, basket weaving, wood shop, ceramics, reading in a group setting and one on one, geography, science. We also have a social club with bingo twice a week and dance and games on Tuesday. Evening events are usually dances or holiday parties.

Center Pointe is able to provide these programs only with the help of community volunteers. Volunteers are always needed in the crafts, reading and social club programs. They also use one-on-one mentors to help clients that are more severely disabled.
