Flexible Scheduling

Designed to meet the needs and schedules of working adults, this program can be completed in as little as 18-24 months. Rolling admissions allows for students to enter the program in either the Fall, Spring, or Summer semester term. Courses are available **evenings, online**, and some are **3-day intensive** workshops with an online component. Also, there are opportunities to spend 2-weeks during the summer studying in **Italy** (additional locations are being considered for the future).

The **M.A. in Organizational Leadership** integrates a holistic liberal arts education with in-depth, practical and theoretical study that inspires students to become the type of leader organizations desire and our world needs most.

Distinctive features of the M.A. in Organizational Leadership are: breadth in understanding human behavior, development of leadership skills with multiple applications, adaptation of models to diverse organizational settings, maximization of career mobility for holders of the degree, individualized degree plans and course patterns, and research projects customized for specific organizational problems.
