

LIMIT TO CANADIAN JOURNALS

All databases have the option of searching for a word in the JOURNAL title. Here are two examples, both using the drop-down menu in the search screen.

LIMIT TO RESEARCH IN CANADA

Each database record usually has a field for the geographic location referred to in the article. Finding the right field name to use can be tricky. For example, in PsycINFO, you would search for Canad* in the **Population Location** field.
