

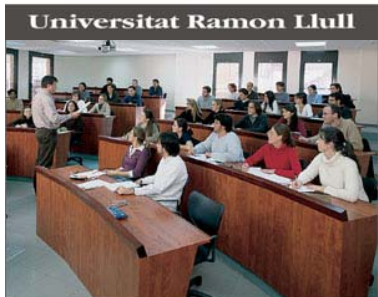

## RAMON LLULL



Universitat Ramon Llull takes its name from Ramon Llull (1232 - 1315), philosopher, poet, and theologian. His writings helped to develop the Romance Catalan language and widely influenced Neoplatonic mysticism throughout medieval and 17th-century Europe.

Born in Palma, Majorca, in the Balearic Islands, then part of the Crown of Aragon, now part of Spain, he is best known in the history of ideas as the inventor of an "art of finding truth" (*ars inveniendi veritatis*) that was primarily intended to support the Roman Catholic faith in missionary work but was also designed to unify all branches of knowledge.

## PASSPORT AND VISAS

All students must have a valid passport to study in Spain and it must be valid three months beyond their stay in Europe. More information will be provided by the Gonzaga University Study Abroad Office.

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

**Spring 2010: May 1, 2009**

Early application is encouraged. Incomplete applications will not be considered until all documents have been received.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Barcelona Exchange program is open to all business undergraduates who have completed sophomore year by the time they study abroad. Admission to the program is based on the following criteria:

- ◆ 3.0 GPA
- ◆ Two letters of academic recommendation
- ◆ Clearance forms

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

2. Student Life clearance form
3. Academic Services clearance form
4. Two academic recommendations
5. \$50 non-refundable application fee payable to Gonzaga Univ.
6. Completed applications will be accepted at the Study Abroad Office, 323 East Boone Avenue.
