



NOTICE OF ZAG ALERT DRILL

Gonzaga University will test the ZagAlert system on Friday, October 12, 2018.

During the drill, the University will send one ZagAlert message, which will be clearly marked as a 'test' message. You will not need to take any kind of protective action.

You may receive the message on multiple platforms, including: email, text, voicemail, or recorded phone call. These messages can arrive to any email, or any telephone number, provided by you. The messages may also appear on our social media accounts.

Text and email messages will include a link to a feedback survey, which will also be advertised on the website and via morning mail. Please take a few moments to answer important questions about the ZagAlert test.

You can verify your information in the ZagAlert system by visiting ZagWeb and selecting the "ZagAlert" tab in your profile. We also encourage all members of the Gonzaga community to download and register the MyConnect app on their mobile devices.
