SPANISH PROGRAM

INFORMATION

- **THIS IS A SPANISH IMMERSION PROGRAM AIMED FOR SPANISH MINORS AND MAJORS. STUDENTS MUST TAKE SPANISH 301 on Gonzaga's campus (and pass it with at least a B grade) BEFORE STUDYING IN GRANADA. A GPA OF 3.0 IN SPANISH IS EXPECTED.**
- All listed courses taken by students in Granada at the “Curso de Estudios Hispánicos” (advanced) level will be counted as upper-division elective credits, except those which fulfill core requirements (Span 302 and Span 409). If students do not qualify for the Curso de Estudios Hispánicos level, they will receive lower division Spanish credits (with the exception of Span 302, Span 409, and 470 when this class is offered).
- Typically a student takes the following classes while in Granada (**In bold, classes that are compulsory**)-
 - a. **Basic Aspects of Spanish Grammar (Nociones de gramática española) (Curso Intensivo de Español)** (first 5 weeks) (4 credits).
 - b. **Spanish Culture and Civilization (Development of Spanish Cultures: A pluralistic Approach) (Cultura y civilización española)** (3 credits)
 - c. **Speaking and Writing Skills (Theory & Practice) (Producción Oral y Escrita, POE)** (3 credits) If a student qualifies for level 8 or 9, students do not need to take this class and can choose another elective from our list.
 - d. 2-3 other classes from the list (6-9 credits) (3-4 classes if student qualifies for levels 8 or 9) *If student qualifies for the intermediate level (Cursos de Lengua y Cultura), one of these classes need to be **Notions of Spanish Grammar** (3 credits).

Total of credits: 16/19

- All Granada students will get preparation for the DELE (Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera) exam. Preparation for the DELE is part of the evaluation of the culture class in Granada. Students will get information about this IMPORTANT component of the program in Granada. The exam will take place at the end of the semester. If passed, student obtains an official Spanish certificate from the Spanish government.

ESTUDIOS HISPÁNICOS (NIVEL AVANZADO)

Each course is 3 credit hours, except for Span 290 which is 4 credits.

Credit given for A&S core **OR** upper-division elective credit in the disciplines listed.

LENGUA Y CULTURA (NIVEL INTERMEDIO)

Students that do not qualify for “Cursos de Estudios Hispánicos” will get lower division Spanish credits with the exception of Span 409, Span 302 (if students did not take that class at GU), and Span 470 (only offered in the Spring Semester).
