How do I sing in a GU Choir?

The four choral ensembles at Gonzaga University are **open to all students**, regardless of major. In addition to music majors and minors, we welcome and depend on undergraduate and graduate students from all programs of study to create a diverse choral community. Gonzaga's choirs pride themselves in achieving musical excellence in a positive and supportive setting. Singers with all levels of experience—from beginner to advanced—are welcome, and the choral placement process aims to match you with the best ensemble. Whether this is your first time singing in a choir or you have extensive choral experience, *there is a place for you!*

Choral Placement – for all students interested in singing in Gonzaga Choirs

Choral Placement—*not an audition*—is an opportunity for you and the conductor to musically get to know each other. This process helps identify your voice part/range for the ensemble that best matches you. You may choose to 1) bring a prepared song or 2) sing a familiar piece like "Amazing Grace," "My Country 'Tis of Thee," or "Happy Birthday." If you bring a prepared song, choose a piece that demonstrates your best musicianship (for music majors/minors, art songs or arias are recommended; bring 1 copy of music for pianist). In addition, we will explore your vocal range through brief exercises.

Signing Up for a Placement Time

When you arrive on campus, sign up for an audition time at the **Music Mansion** (Monaghan Mansion), and pick up a yellow **Choral Info Card** to bring with you to your appointment. Placement takes place during the beginning of the first week of classes, so sign up early!
