Most recently, Dr. Carey served as the Dean of the Virtual Campus at Gonzaga University, which served students and faculty involved in online learning. He is currently Associate Professor and Chairperson of the Department of Organizational Leadership and Coordinator of the Servant Leadership Concentration in the School of Leadership Studies.
