There are many ways students finance their graduate education at Gonzaga University.

Helpful tips to get started:

- 1. **Graduate tuition is billed differently than undergraduate tuition.** You are only expected to pay for the credits you are enrolled in each term (plus fees if applicable).
- 2. **Compare value**. As you narrow your search, compare the value of the programs you are considering. While cost is an important factor, it shouldn't be the sole factor. Ensure the program is a personal fit, provides the best professional outcome, quality and school reputation.
- 3. **Explore outside avenues**. Check outside agencies where you may be able to find financial support. Start locally, then expand outside your general area.
- 4. **File your FAFSA**. Submit your FAFSA to us as soon as possible, then our financial aid office can determine your eligibility.
