3. Enter your Login ID. This is your Gonzaga ID. We emailed you your Gonzaga ID shortly after you applied. If you need us to give this to you again, please email us at admissions@gonzaga.edu.
4. Enter your PIN. This is your birth date in 6 digits. Use this format: MMDDYY. For example, April 13, 2000 is 041300.

Teacher Recommendation Information

First-Year Applicants: Because we want to hear how you've performed in your most rigorous classes, Gonzaga requires a recommendation from a high school teacher in an academic subject area (i.e. math, science, English, history, foreign language, etc.) A non-academic recommendation will fulfill the requirement, but we strongly encourage you to submit a recommendation from a high school teacher in an academic subject area. If your teacher is unable to upload the Recommendation form to Common App, you can access a blank copy [HERE](#) for him or her to email directly to us at admissions@gonzaga.edu.

Transfer Applicants: The Academic Evaluation form is a document that can be completed by an Advisor or Professor who can recommend your academic performance. If you need access to the Academic Evaluation form, please click [HERE](#).

School Report Information - FIRST-YEAR APPLICANTS ONLY

The School Report is a form typically filled out by your high school counselor and submitted via the Common Application site. It contains your current year courses, biographical information about your high school, a brief recommendation, and finally, indicates if you have a disciplinary or criminal record. Homeschooled students may have a parent fill out this form. If your counselor is unable to upload the School Report to Common App, you can access a blank copy [HERE](#) for him or her to email directly to us at admissions@gonzaga.edu.

College Report Information - TRANSFER APPLICANTS ONLY
