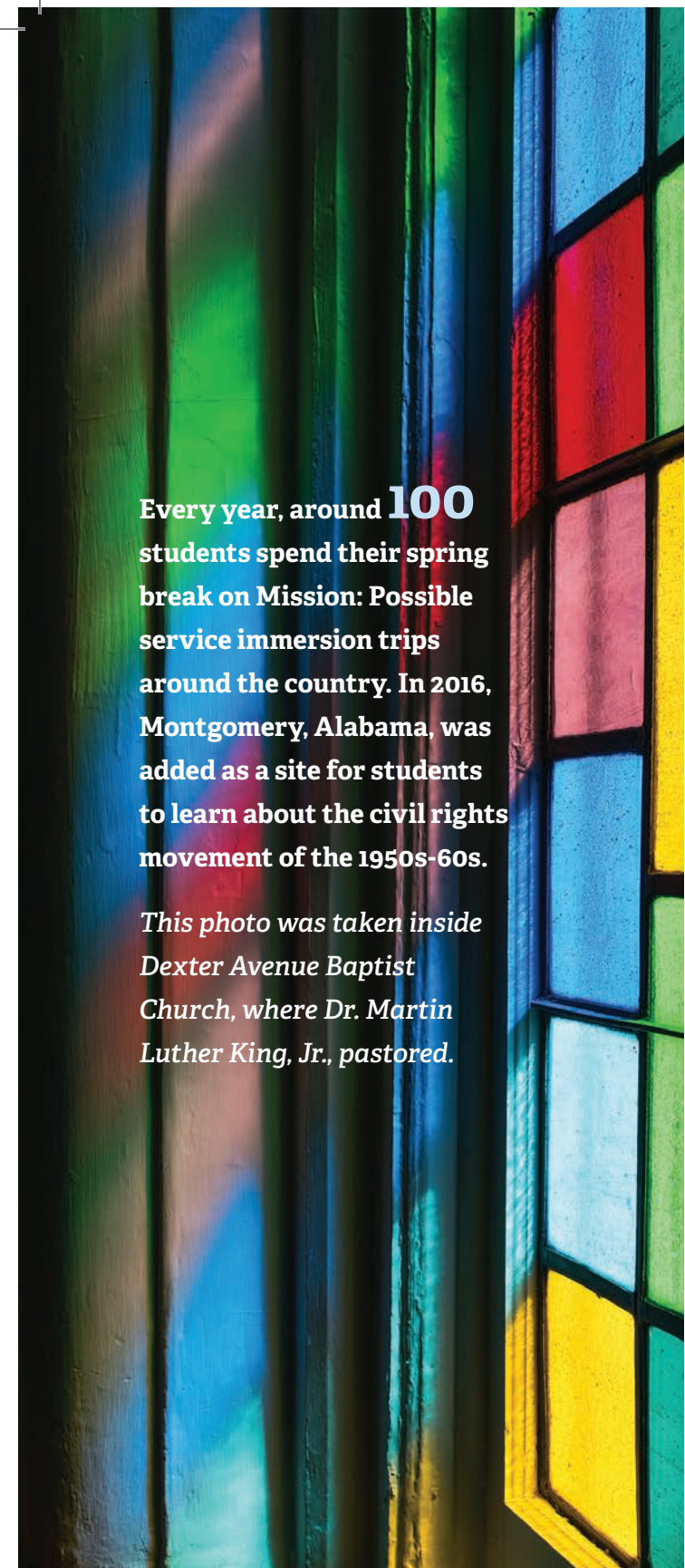
# Unsung

**Rhonda Young**, associate professor of civil engineering, was among four recipients of the Institute of Transportation Engineers' Innovation in Education Award in 2016. Rhonda has performed seven years of work as a member of the ITE's University Transportation Curriculum project, which seeks to enhance undergraduate transportation engineering education.

**Brian Higginson**, Human Physiology assistant professor, presented research at the Fourth International Congress on Soldiers' Physical Performance.

**Gena Hoxha**, Gonzaga University DECA adviser, was elected chair of the Washington Marketing & Management Educators Association at the 2017 College DECA International Career Development Conference in Anaheim, California.

**Lisa Silvestri**, assistant professor of communications, received a two-year, \$100,000 grant for her humanities-based initiative "Telling War." The project will utilize visual arts and writing to engage military veterans and civilians in meaningful dialogue. Previously, Silvestri wrote a book titled "Friended at the Front: Social Media in the American War Zone."

For the second year, the School of Education hosted the Young Child Expo & Conference for professionals helping children reach their full potential. Children from the Salish School of Spokane performed for more than 500 attendees.



**Sports Ministry at Gonzaga**

The School of Education's Center for Catholic Education included a pilot sports ministry program developed by Assistant Professor Jimmy Smith in Sport and Physical Education for Trinity Catholic School.

**Access to Catholic Resources at Foley**

The Foley Center Library was accepted for membership in the Catholic Research Resources Alliance, an organization that promotes collaborative approaches to promoting access to scholarly Catholic resources.

**Good Neighbor Conference Addresses Hate Through Advocacy and Action**

The Gonzaga Institute for Hate Studies joined the Spokane Interfaith Council, online religion publication Spokane Faith & Values, and the Spokane County Human Rights Task Force to organize the conference centered on peace and goodwill in December 2016. It included a series of discussions, workshops and seminars aimed at helping community members advocate for themselves and their neighbors.

**Students, Alumnus Compose for Spring Dance Concert**

Gonzaga alumnus Jeff Rosick ('08), who acts and composes commercial music, created the music for Dance Program Director Suzanne Ostersmith's original dance piece, "Unfolding." Master of Organizational Leadership student Casey Robert Adams and undergraduate student Ian Loe ('18) also composed music for the show. This was the first time original work by an alumnus and Gonzaga students accompanied the Spring Dance Concert.

# Unprecedented

There is no doubt that the highlight of the 2016-17 year was the Men's Basketball team's journey to the NCAA championship. The national spotlight was a victory not only for the Athletics department, but for all of Zag Nation - the entire university, the broader Spokane community and alumni around the globe.





### Innovation in the College of Arts and Sciences, 2016-17

- The Center for Public Humanities, directed by **Brian Cooney (pictured)**, professor of English. The center focused on veterans throughout the academic year, with guest speakers and authors relating veteran experiences.
- The Center for Undergraduate Research and Creative Inquiry, directed by **Jeff Watson**, associate professor of chemistry and biochemistry. The goal is to expand undergraduate research and creative inquiry opportunities, assist departments with designing and incorporating research into curricula, provide a clearinghouse to fund research, and build awareness of the transformative educational experiences that occur through student-faculty research collaborations.
- Digital Humanities, directed by **Katey Roden**, English lecturer and visiting scholar. The initiative aims to leverage technology to increase knowledge and scholarship in the humanities, and encourages students to become more thoughtful consumers and producers of digital media.
- Collaborations with Pontificia Universidad Javeriana in Cali, Colombia. Four faculty were selected by their peers through a competitive process to study Spanish, and engage in teaching and research collaborations with their Colombian counterparts.

### Gonzaga Students Win at DECA Conference

Twenty-one Gonzaga students were among nearly 1,500 international and American students who competed in the Collegiate DECA International Career Development Conference. Eleven Gonzaga students in six competitive events advanced to the final competition.

### Researching Sleep

Assistant professor of psychology **Sarah Arpin's** research concluded that partners who share good news and believe their partners are receptive and supportive sleep better. The research was part of a five-year Study for the Employment Retention of Veterans (SERVe) funded by the U.S. Department of Defense. In the future, Arpin hopes to explore the study's findings in more depth, including the types of positive events shared, the effects on loneliness and intimacy, and the impact of sleep quality of responsiveness.

### Erin Hays

Director of Undergraduate Admission

Erin quietly goes over the top for students. She has done amazing work, with impressive outcomes in staff development, recruitment strategies, and work with first-generation and underrepresented students. Erin maintains relationships with students and parents for years; she invites them to holiday meals, holds pizza parties to make sure students are doing okay, and mentors and helps students in need. She is an intelligent, wise colleague, and a compassionate student mentor.

### 25th Annual Economics Symposium

The School of Business hosted the 25th Annual Economics Symposium with speaker Christina Romer '57, the Gariff B. Wilson Professor of Economics at the University of California, Berkeley.

## Unprecedented

Gonzaga Men's Basketball Head Coach **Mark Few** received the Associated Press and Naismith College Basketball Coach of the Year awards and the same honors from USA Today, NBC Sports, Sporting News and the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.



### Nigel Williams-Goss ('17)

First Team Academic All-American Division I Basketball

Williams-Goss completed his undergraduate degree in psychology with a 3.84 GPA. He is the sixth Zag named an Academic All-American First Team by the College Sports Information Directors of America.



### NCAA Academic Public Recognition Awards

The NCAA Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Awards ranked Gonzaga second in the nation with 73.3 percent of its teams earning the honor. Eleven of Gonzaga's 15 teams earned the recognition, including baseball, women's and men's basketball, women's and men's cross country, women's and men's track, men's and women's golf, men's soccer and women's tennis. The Gonzaga men's basketball team was the only 2017 Final Four team to earn public recognition.

**Leadership Students Win at International Competition**

A four-person team of Gonzaga seniors from the Comprehensive Leadership Program (CLP) won first place and \$1,000 in the International Leadership Association (ILA) Conference’s undergraduate case-study competition. This was the fourth ILA conference attended by a Gonzaga CLP team. Past teams placed first at the 2013 Montreal conference, first at Barcelona in 2015, and second at San Diego in 2014.

**25-Year Anniversary of the Gonzaga Women’s and Gender Studies Department**

Mary Jo Bona, professor and chair of the women’s gender and sexuality studies department at the State University of New York at Stony Brook and a co-founder of the GU women’s and gender studies department, delivered the keynote lecture at an event honoring the milestone, “Twenty Five Years and Counting: Women’s Studies as a Field and the Queer Daughter’s Voice.”



**Women Lead Conference**

More than **300** participants from nearly 60 organizations attended two Women Lead conferences offered by the School of Professional Studies, in Spokane and Seattle.



**Marnie Rorholm ('21)**  
Eva Lassman Memorial Student Research Award Recipient

Marnie, a student in Gonzaga’s Doctoral Program in Leadership Studies, received the Eva Lassman Memorial Student Research Award through Gonzaga’s Institute for Hate Studies. The award includes a \$700 stipend to assist in her study of the memorialization of homophobia in the Holocaust. Rorholm is also the office manager for the Gonzaga’s ROTC.



**Art Díaz ('17)**  
Award-winning playwright

Art received the Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival’s Artists Striving to End Poverty scholarship for his play “A La Roro,” which reflects a personal struggle with his Mexican-American identity, and the weight of political and social conflicts during childhood.

**Chad Hicks ('18)**  
Howard Hughes Medical Institute Internship Recipient

Biochemistry major Chad Hicks’s 2017 HHMI summer internship research at Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia, focused on structures associated with brain and nervous system disorders. Hicks was one of 67 students nationwide chosen for the program and the sixth Gonzaga student since 2010.

**Aizley Hansen ('18)**  
Boren Scholarship Recipient

Hansen, who majors in international relations and political science at Gonzaga, is studying Swahili in Tanzania through a prestigious Boren Scholarship from the International Institute for Education. Less than 200 undergraduates received awards, from a pool of almost 800 applications.

Award-Winning Writer

A biology major who hopes to work as a physician, Ahern won first place in the 2017 Norton Writer’s Prize competition for an essay titled “Ourselves,” which recounts his experience as a high schooler recovering the body of an avalanche victim while volunteering with King County Search and Rescue.

Ochoa is a Campus Compact Newman Civic Fellow for her work as a peer mentor, tutor and summer BRIDGE program leader, where she welcomes underrepresented students to campus.

**Expansion of Global Engagement**

Representatives from the School of Business,  
College of Arts and Sciences and Center for  
Global Engagement visited Ningbo, China, to  
evaluate program opportunities. Six faculty  
also traveled to Colombia and Zambia over  
the summer. The Gonzaga Chamber Chorus  
embarked on a musical tour in southern  
Africa, singing in joint concerts with local  
choirs from Lusaka and the Chikuni Mission  
in Zambia, and Victoria Falls and Harare,  
Zimbabwe. The First Annual Human Rights  
Symposium in Florence, Italy, took place in  
May featuring international leaders in human  
rights advocacy and law.

## Gonzaga Will: Campaign progress\*

Nearly two years after launching the largest capital campaign in university history, Gonzaga has announced that the original \$250 million goal has been surpassed. Following are some of the unparalleled achievements of this effort.

- More than 36,000 supporters worldwide
- \$27.6 million in commitments for new faculty positions and programs
- \$58.8 million in commitments to establish 266 new scholarships

In terms of facilities, progress or completion of projects is as follows:

- Della Strada Jesuit Community construction reached its final stages during the 2016-17 year; Jesuits moved into their new residence in November 2017.
- Volkar Center for Athletic Achievement construction is wrapping up and a dedication is planned for spring 2018
- Myrtle Woldson Performing Arts Center construction is underway, with an opening anticipated in late 2018
- Integrated Science and Engineering facility, in design

More than **25 local, regional and national experts** delivered lectures at Gonzaga on topics ranging from business ethics and international relations to religious violence and media influence.

### First-year Success with UW School of Medicine

In its inaugural year, Gonzaga's new Regional Health Partnership with the University of Washington School of Medicine named Courtney Law as its director and Darryl K. Potyk, M.D., as chief of medical education. In September 2016, 60 medical students arrived on the Gonzaga campus – the largest-ever class of first-year medical students in Spokane – joining 40 second-year students. The Regional Health Partnership also established a Spokane Advisory Board to work with the community to identify opportunities, and engage in collaborative solutions to improve eastern Washington's economy. Chaired by Mike Wilson, retired CEO of Providence Sacred Heart Medical Center & Children's Hospital, the board includes business, civic and healthcare leaders from the greater Spokane area. Five Gonzaga faculty members are contracting with UW to teach for the School of Medicine in Spokane.

- > The university's carbon footprint has decreased by 16 percent since 2009, with a commitment to reduce it by 20 percent by 2020

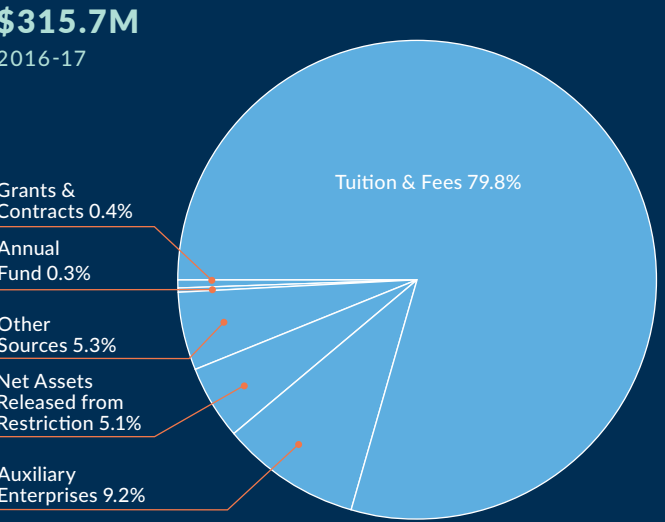

AS OF MAY 31, 2017, IN MILLIONS

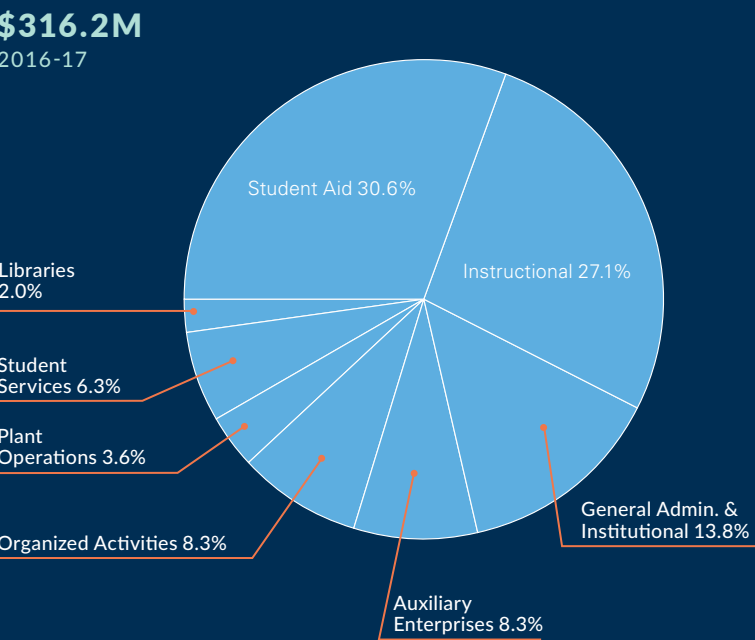

OPERATING REVENUES



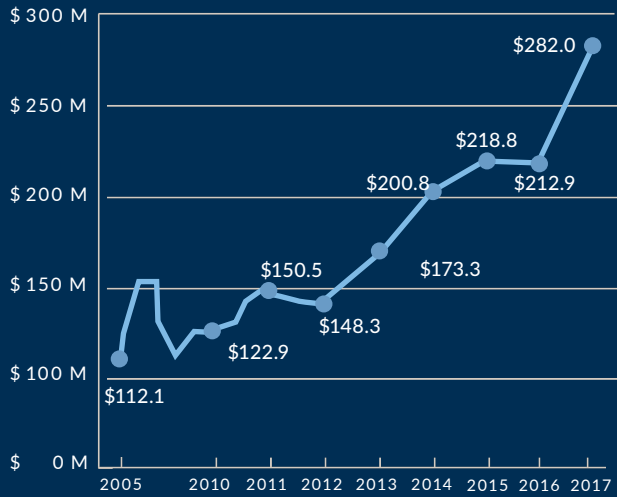
Unrestricted gross operating revenues

OPERATING EXPENSES



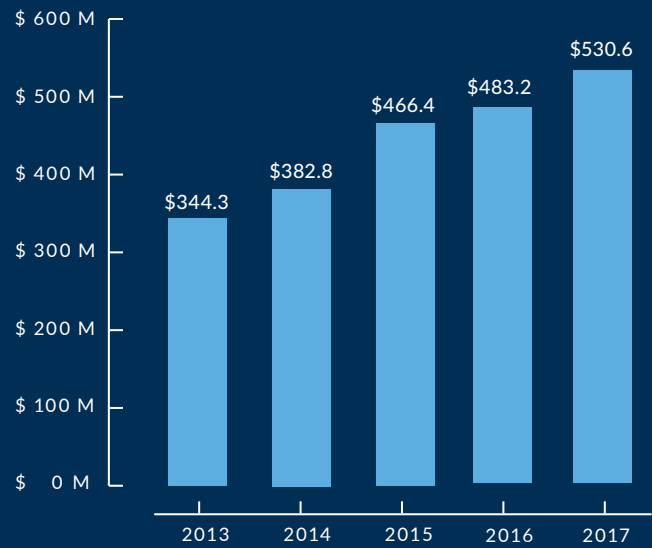
Unrestricted gross operating expenses
