Items to bring to campus for health and safety related to COVID-19:

Cloth Face Coverings

- Multiple cloth face coverings are recommended (up to one for each day to allow for washing)

Personal Cleaning and Disinfecting Supplies for Your Space

- Up to three items that can be replaced when empty

- Use when soap and water are not accessible

Personal Digital Thermometer

- Use for daily temperature checks to self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19

Easy to Clean/Disinfect Plastic Bin for Toiletries

- Use to tote toiletries to avoid placing individual items on sinks, counter spaces, and other high touch areas
