

The RC receives reports of alleged misconduct and complaints against a student from a variety of sources, including but not limited to:


- Housing & Residence Life

- These reports are reviewed by staff in the Resolution Center to determine if there is sufficient information that a violation of the Student Code of Conduct may have occurred.




Investigation


