LOEKEN ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD

Description: This award recognizes one faculty member for all-around academic excellence.

Criteria: The basis for evaluation will be teaching excellence, intellectual contributions, service, and other professional activities, in that order. Your letter of application should address:

- Teaching: (a) methodology and innovation; (b) instructional development (new course(s)) development, course revision); and (c) teaching evaluations,
- Intellectual Contributions: (a) peer-reviewed journal articles; (b) peer-refereed proceedings; (c) academic conference presentations; (d) texts; (e) working papers; and (f) other. If any of your works are co-authored, you also should address your contribution to the paper.
- Service: Application of business discipline expertise to: (a) offices or positions held in professional associations, academic reviewer, conference or chair/discussant; (b) community or not-for-profit organizations; (c) University or School of business committees.
- Other professional activities that support the application.

Other criteria include:

- Applicant must have been full-time and/or on sabbatical during the 2018-2019 academic year.
- Administrators with the titles of Associate Dean or Dean (any flavor) are not eligible for this award.
- Applicant must not have received the Loeken Academic Excellence Award in the past three years.

Please note that the recipient of this award will not be eligible for a SBA Faculty Fellowship Award.

LOEKEN SBA VISION & VALUES AWARD

(2 @ \$4,500)

Description: This award recognizes two faculty members for their significant contribution in helping the SBA fulfill its vision and live its values:

Your letter should also address the AACSB goals of innovation and impact. Please feel free to provide whatever supporting documentation you feel necessary to make your case.

Other criteria include:

- Applicant must have been full-time and/or on sabbatical during the (Lada's former office) 2018-2019 academic year.
- Administrators with the titles of Associate Dean or Dean (any flavor) are not eligible for this award.
- Applicant must not have received the Loeken Vision & Values Award in the past three years.

CENTIOLI FACULTY SCHOLARS EXCELLENCE AWARD

(2 @ \$3,000)

Description: This award recognizes two faculty members for all-around academic excellence.

Criteria: The basis for evaluation will be the equally weighted categories of intellectual contributions and teaching effectiveness. Within category, criteria are prioritized as follows:

Intellectual Contributions: (1) peer-reviewed publications; (2) peer-reviewed paper (national conference); (3) peer-reviewed paper (regional conference); and (4) other (e.g., texts, book chapters, monographs, professional publications). If any of the above are co-authored, you also should address your relative contribution to the work.

Teaching Effectiveness: (1) methodology and innovation; (2) instructional development (e.g., new course development, course revisions); (3) teaching evaluations (e.g., student, peer, other).

Other criteria include:

- Applicant must have been full-time and/or on sabbatical during the 2018-2019 academic year,
- Administrators with the titles of Associate Dean or Dean (any flavor) are not eligible for this award.
- Applicant must not have received a Centioli award in the past three years.

Please note that recipients of this award will not be eligible for a SBA Faculty Fellowship Award.

Vision Awards

Vision awards include the academic excellence, engagement, and inspiration awards. Application for a vision award requires a 300-word description of meeting the criteria of one of the awards below. Applicants can apply for two awards. Applications of more than 300 words will not be considered.

Barnes Academic Excellence Award Application (\$5,000)

This award recognizes excellence in teaching and academic advising. Research is a part of academic excellence but is recognized in other awards. Possible areas for distinction could include:

- Diversity and Inclusion initiatives
- Creative, quality instruction techniques
- Experiential learning initiatives
- Effectively incorporating scholarship into the classroom
- Bringing national recognition to the SBA
- Exemplary academic service to the SBA or the discipline

Barnes Engagement Award Application (\$5,000)

This award recognizes engagement with the university and business community. This includes service and involving the business community in the school (e.g., bringing business practitioners to the classroom or bringing the classroom to them). This does not include engagement with the scholarly community (e.g., attendance or presentation at an academic conference) as this is recognized in other awards. Possible areas for distinction could include:

- Volunteerism
- Service-learning
- Educational programming and outreach
- Partnerships with community stakeholders
- Real-world implementation
- Community-engaged learning

Barnes Inspiration Award Application (\$5,000)

This award recognizes engagement with the Jesuit mission of the university through teaching, research, advising or service. Possible areas for distinction could include:

- Integration of mission topics in the classroom
- Integration of mission topics in research
- Leadership in mission activities on campus
- Student mentoring activities
- Sustainability initiatives
- Social justice initiatives
