

How to install and use the Sender App for Hiperwall (PC and Mac)

The sender app allows individual computers to send their display output to the control PC for use on the Hiperwall or mobile displays. The Sender app needs to be downloaded, installed and configured. Once set up, it is just one click to get it going. The steps below are for PC set up. For Mac, just go to the link below, download the Jar file, place it on the desktop and then skip to #6 to add IP information.

- 1) Go to <http://www.gonzaga.edu/hiperwall>.
- 2) Download the **Hiperwall Sender Setup** zip file.
- 3) Unzip **Hiperwall Sender** setup file. If you need a program to open zip files such as WinZip, call the help desk at 5550 to have it installed.

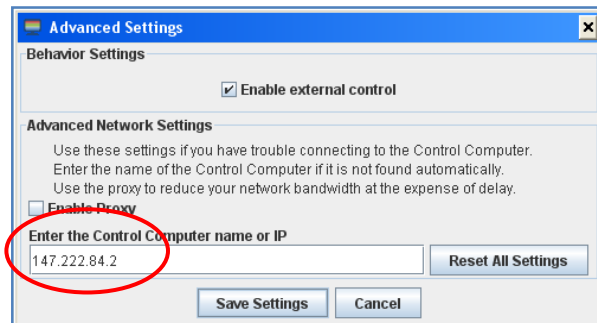
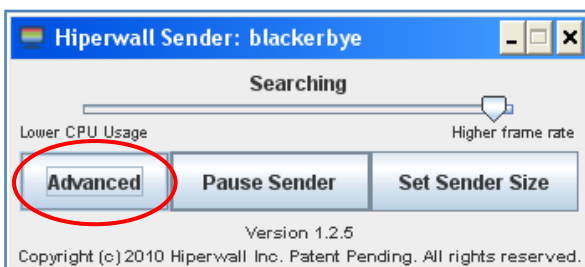
- 4) Install unzipped file **Hiperwall Sender Setup.exe**



- 5) Double-click on **Hiperwall Sender icon** on desktop to launch Sender app.



- 6) Click on **Advanced** to set IP (You should only have to do this the first time it is used). Enter IP **147.222.84.2** and choose **Save**.



You now be connected and it should say **“connected to 147.222.84.2”**.

If you get a message where it says **“Searching”** and does not connect, click advanced and enter in the IP again. There may be times when it loses the IP address.
